Palliser appointed to NEC; Ministers assume new roles

The Ordinary Member for Rigolet, Carlene Palliser, has been appointed to serve as Minister of Education and Economic Development, replacing the Ordinary Member for Hopedale, Greg Flowers, who moves to Lands and Natural Resources. Mr. Flowers takes over from Nain Ordinary Member Tony Andersen, who has assumed the position of Minister of Finance, Human Resources and Information Technology.

The appointments were made today by President Johannes Lampe, on the advice of First Minister Tyler Edmunds, during a sitting of the Nunatsiavut Assembly in Hopedale.
