**Child Intervention Services Manager**  
Temporary full-time (5 yr. term)  
Nunatsiavut (Nain, Hopedale, Makkovik, Postville or Rigolet)

Under the Director of Mental Wellness and Healing, the Child Intervention Services Manager is responsible for the coordination of the Child First Intervention Services Program. This program is intended to work with children/youth with special needs and their families to promote positive child development – including medical, mental health and, educational needs – for all Nunatsiavummiut aged 0-18years.

**Duties to include but not limited to:**

- Develop and oversee the Child First Intervention Services Program with the intent to:
  - 1) educate and prepare families to meet children's developmental needs
  - 2) coordinate access to child specialist services and Child First Initiative where needed
  - 3) support families in implementing the care plans for children/youth with special needs
- Oversee and supervise all program staff, manage team performance by setting expectations and acting as a coach/mentor for clinical support
- Provide clinical supervision to the development and implementation of supportive care plans for child and youth with special needs, including supporting staff in referral to and case management of necessary specialists/professionals
- Coordinate and oversee the delivery of the Child First Initiative for Labrador Inuit children
- Liaise with health, education, and social service agencies in delivery of services which promote child development (eg. occupational therapy, speech and language therapy, psychology, BMS/CMS, physiotherapy, pediatrician, Janeway Development Team, FASD Clinic, etc).
- Lead the development of materials and training which will educate parents, community members, and staff regarding child development, means of supporting child development and support the development and implementation of innovative programming and policy, maintaining service standards, and overseeing professional and community development

**Qualifications:**

- Bachelor's degree (Masters Preferred) with focus on child development and intervention modalities, etc (eg. Occupational Therapy, Nursing, Educational Counselling, etc).
- Minimum 5 years clinical experience working with children and youth, including completion of developmental and/or functional assessments, clinical intervention, and multi-disciplinary care plans
- Minimum 3 years experience in program management and staff supervision, including program development and evaluation
- Significant knowledge of child development and socio-emotional learning, including assessments, techniques, and tools to promote child development

- Kaujimallagiutsalu suguset pigutsagusingit ilinniagutigisongillu, ilaliutillugit Kaujisagutiusot, atuttauguset, KaujitsitsiKattagiagutellu.
