EXECUTIVE ORDER AUTHORIZING THE MINISTER OF LANDS AND NATURAL RESOURCES TO TRANSFER ADMINISTRATION AND CONTROL OF AN AREA OF LABRADOR INUIT LANDS AT HEBRON TO ANOTHER MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

WHEREAS the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources of the Nunatsiavut Government considers it appropriate to transfer of the administration and control of a certain portion of Labrador Inuit Lands to the Minister of Language Culture and Tourism of the Nunatsiavut Government;

AND WHEREAS section 2.3 *Labrador Inuit Lands Act* requires that the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources obtain the written consent of the Executive Council to such a transfer;

AND WHEREAS the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources has assured the Executive Council that the transfer will be carried out in accordance with the requirements of section 2.4 of the *Labrador Inuit Lands Act*;

NOW THEREFORE The President of Nunatsiavut, acting with the consent and advice of the Executive Council, is pleased to **ORDER** that:

Authority

This Executive Order is made under section 2.3 of the Labrador Inuit Lands Act.

Interpretation

Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this Executive Order have the same meaning as in the *Labrador Inuit Lands Act*.

Approval of Transfer

The Executive Counsel herby consents to the transfer of administration and control of the following portion of Labrador Inuit Lands from the Minister of Lands and Natural Resources to the Minister of Language Culture and Tourism, which hereinafter is referred to as the "Lot":

All of that portion of Labrador Inuit Lands depicted in the attached Certificate of Land Transfer as application No. A2019_021, located at Hebron.

The transfer of administration and control of the Lot described herein in no way affects the continuing status of the Lot as Labrador Inuit Lands and the *Labrador Inuit Lands Act* shall continue to apply to the lot including, without restricting the generality of the forgoing, section 2.5 of that Act.

All that piece or parcel of land situated at Hebron, within Labrador Inuit Land Parcel 4 (LIL-04) of the Labrador Inuit Settlement Area being abutted and bounded as follows, that is to say: Beginning at a point in the vicinity of Hebron, said point having Universal Transverse Mercator Zone 20th projection coordinates of \$22071 metres East (TE) and &650812 metres North (mN). Thence following a southwestern heading of \$21,7609 degrees for a distance of approximately 49.14 metres to a second proint having coordinates \$52092 mE and 6450781 mM. Thence following a northwestern heading of \$27,422 degrees for a distance of approximately 72.47 metres to a point having coordinates \$52193 mE and 6450842 mN. Thence following a northeastern heading of \$27,422 degrees for a distance of approximately 4.771 metres to a point having coordinates \$22029 mE and 6450870 mN. Thence to the point of origin following a southeastern heading of 443,3227 degrees for a distance of approximately 71.56 metres, containing in all an area of approximately \$0.337 hectares, more or less.
