



REQUEST FOR PROPOSALS CURRICULUM DEVELOPMENT

Summary of Scope of Work:

The Nunatsiavut Government (NG) requires further development in the area of Inuit specific curriculum and resource development for schools in Nunatsiavut. There has been much success with the development and delivery of the Labrador Inuit Society & Culture 2211 course and release of the accompanying textbook *InukKutivut IlukKusivut: Our People, Our Culture*. NG is now looking to expand this course content to reach students from grade Kindergarten to grade 9 with the development of modules to accompany existing provincial curriculum.

NG is seeking a qualified firm to further develop culturally relevant curriculum, resources and explore the certification of new courses with the NLESD and Department of Education and Early Childhood Development of the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador.

Proposals are to be received no later than **4:00 p.m. on May 11, 2020** at the Nunatsiavut Government offices in Makkovik, Nunatsiavut.

Before submitting proposals, interested proponents are required to obtain the full detailed scope of work, instructions and requirements for proposals, and any further information on the project from the Director of Education:

Proposals will be evaluated on the principles of value for money, which include an evaluation of the Inuit Content Factor pursuant to the *Procurement Act*.
