COVID-19 Marine Harvesters Support Program

Beneficiaries of the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement are advised that gasoline allowances will be provided to qualifying applicants under the newly-established Nunatsiavut COVID-19 Marine Harvesters Support Program. At the same time, gasoline allowances for snowmobiles will be suspended in all Labrador Inuit Communities on or before June 1, 2020. The suspension came into effect in the Inuit Community of Rigolet today.

Under the new program, allowances will be provided to qualifying boat owners to cover costs associated with harvesting country foods on behalf of themselves and/or other family units.

Individuals who meet the criteria can apply to receive a voucher for 50 litres of gasoline per week. Family units owning a boat can also be designated to harvest on behalf of **one** other family unit that has been approved for emergency relief.
