Youth Center Summer Student

The **Youth Centre Summer Student** will assist staff with special activities planned for different occasions while building connections with other youth in the community. The summer student will be required to learn safe work practices, safely prepare and handle food, maintain general housekeeping. This position will involve shifts during nights/evening.

Youth Outreach Summer Student

The **Youth Outreach Summer Student** will be working directly with the Youth Outreach Worker. Duties will include but not limited to preparing and participating in the land based and youth centre activities while building connections with the youth in the community. The summer student will also assist the Youth Outreach Worker with general paperwork, taking appointments and learning safe work practices.

Inuktitut Language Summer Student

Under the supervision of the Language Program Coordinator, the *Inuktitut Language Summer Student* will assist with facilitating summer language and culture experiences under the Department of Language, Culture & Tourism. Duties will include organizing and filing documents, working with community organizations to promote Inuktitut, assist with developing language and culture programs and recourse, research funding options and other indigenous language strategies.
