

**REGULATION TO AMEND THE *DISQUALIFICATION OF CANDIDATES REGULATION, 2018*
TO SPECIFY METHODS OF TAX VERIFICATION FOR CANDIDATES IN NUNATSIAVUT
ELECTIONS**

The Nunatsiavut Electoral Officer is pleased to enact the following regulations:

Short Title

1.

These regulations may be cited as the *Disqualification of Candidates Regulation (Amendment)*.

Authority

2.

These regulations are made under subsection 5(9) of the *Nunatsiavut Elections Act* (the "*Act*").

Interpretation

3.

Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in this regulation have the same meaning as in the *Act*.

Amendment

4.

Section 8 of the *Disqualification of Candidates Regulation, 2018* is amended by deleting subsection (1) and replacing it with the following:

- (1) To allow the NEO to determine that a candidate is not disqualified under clause 28(3)(g) of the *Act*, a person who wishes to be nominated as a candidate shall provide to the NEO, prior to the closing of the nomination period, a copy of:
 - (a) A printout from the person's Canada Revenue Agency's MyAccount online service showing the account balance and statement of account of the person as of the date of the opening of nominations; or
 - (b) the person's Notice of Assessment from the Canada Revenue Agency for the tax year ending December 31st immediately prior to the date of the election.

Effective Date

5.

This Regulation shall be considered for all purposes to have come into effect on the 1st day of July, 2020.
