- Provide support during the delivery of community-based and land-based trauma and addiction programming.
- Individual/group peer support counselling services.
- Engage with individuals who are attending trauma and addictions programming.
- Provide input and support during programming and staff meetings.
- Share information and build capacity for peer support.
- Prepare for community-based or land-based programming.
- Maintain necessary documentation, including monthly service reports and client case notes.
- Other related duties as required.

Qualifications:

- Peer Support Accreditation and Certification – through the Mental Health Commission of Canada, diploma in community studies, Indigenous studies or equivalent.
- Experiential understanding of intergenerational trauma and its impacts
- Knowledge of Inuit history, culture, and way of life
- In addition, the successful candidate will be willing to spend a significant portion of time travelling for work-related activities in the Nunatsiavut region
- Willing to be trained in Peer Support Certification through the Mental Health Commission of Canada, if required.
