

NUNATSIAVUT ASSEMBLY

ACT TO AMEND THE NUNATSIAVUT LAWS REGISTRATION ACT,
CIL 31-12-2012 N-9

Be it enacted by the President of Nunatsiavut and the Nunatsiavut Assembly as follows:

1. **Section 2 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by**
 - (a) **deleting the word “enactments” in line 2 and replacing it with “Enactments”;**
and
 - (b) **deleting the words “and the Constitution”.**

2. **Section 3 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended as follows:**
 - (a) **in the definition of “Act” deleting the words “Inuit Law” and replacing them with “Act of the Assembly”;**
 - (b) **in the definition of “Assembly” deleting the words “the Nunatsiavut Transitional Assembly as constituted under the *Nunatsiavut Transitional Assembly Act* and”;**
 - (c) **in the definition of “Bylaw” deleting the words “an enactment of” and replacing them with “a law made by”;**
 - (d) **in the definition of “Enactment” deleting the first reference to “Bylaw,”;**
 - (e) **in the definition of “Inuit Law” deleting the words “of the Assembly assented to by the President”; and**
 - (f) **in the definition of “Subordinate Legislation” deleting the words “by the President, the President-in-Council or by a Minister”.**

3. **Section 5 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by inserting the words “for the maintenance and publication of all Enactments” immediately following the word “office”.**

4. **Section 6 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by renumbering the section as subsection (1) and adding the following two subsections:**
 - (2) The President shall appoint the Registrar.
 - (3) The Registrar is responsible to the President for the performance of the Registrar’s duties and functions under this Act.

5. **Section 8 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended as follows:**
 - (a) **in subsection (a) inserting the words “and Enactments” immediately after “documents”;**
 - (b) **in subsection (c) deleting the word “enactment” and replacing it with “Enactment”; and**
 - (c) **in subsection (d) deleting the word “enactment” and replacing it with “Enactment”.**

6. **Section 9 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” and replacing it with “Enactment”.**

7. **Section 10 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the heading and replacing it with “Validity of Enactments”.**
8. **Section 13 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by renumbering the section as subsection (1) and adding the following subsection:**
 - (2) Notwithstanding anything in subsection 13 (1) to the contrary, a consolidation of an Enactment shall be considered to have come into effect at the time when the most recent amendment incorporated into the consolidation came into effect.
9. **Section 14 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by**
 - (a) **deleting the first two words and replacing them with “Unless otherwise specifically stated, an Enactment or a provision in an Enactment”; and**
 - (b) **deleting the word “enactment” in the second line and replacing it with “Enactment”.**
10. **Section 15 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” wherever it appears and replacing it with “Enactment” in each instance.**
11. **Section 16 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the words “subordinate legislation” and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”.**
12. **Section 19 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the words “subordinate legislation” and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”.**
13. **Subsection 20(e) of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the words “in each Inuit Community”.**
14. **Section 21 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by:**
 - (a) **renumbering the section as subsection (1);**
 - (b) **in subsection (a), deleting the words “the current” and replacing them with “each”;**
 - (c) **in subsection (b), deleting the word “legislation” and replacing it with “Legislation”, deleting the words “and Executive Council appointments for the current” and replacing them with “for each calendar” and inserting “and” after the semicolon;**
 - (d) **in subsection (c), deleting the words “to be maintained in the relevant Community” and replacing them with “for each calendar year” and deleting the semicolon and “and” and replacing them with a period; and**
 - (e) **deleting subsection (d)**
15. **Section 21 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is further amended by adding the following subsection:**
 - (2) Each Inuit Community Government shall maintain publicly accessible registers of all Bylaws made by the Inuit Community Government as follows:

- (a) a compilation of all Bylaws enacted in each calendar year arranged chronologically by year; and
 - (b) a current continuing consolidation of all Bylaws in effect in the Inuit Community.
- 16. **Section 22 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” wherever it appears and replacing it with “Enactment” in each instance.**
- 17. **Section 23 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by**
 - (a) **deleting the word “Registrar” in the first line and replacing it with “Director of Legal Services”;**
 - (b) **deleting the words in subsection (a) and replacing them with “making the revisions to the Enactment that are required by the amendment”;** **and**
 - (c) **inserting the words “other than those made under subsections (c), (d) and (e)” immediately before the period at the end.**
- 18. **Section 24 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by**
 - (a) **renumbering the section as subsection 24(1);**
 - (b) **deleting the word “Registrar” wherever it appears and replacing it in each instance with “Director of Legal Services”;**
 - (c) **deleting the words “by the Nunatsiavut Executive Council,” in subsection (a);**
 - (d) **deleting the words “subordinate legislation” in subsection (a) and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”;** **and**
 - (e) **adding a new subsection (2) as follows:**
 - (2) The Registrar may enter an Enactment in a collection of consolidations without an approval referred to in subsection (1) where the Enactment has not been amended, or where the Enactment replaces a prior Enactment of the same name or where the only amendments made to the Enactment were made under paragraphs 23 (c), (d) or (e). (IL 2016-)
- 19. **Section 25 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the words “subordinate legislation” in the first line and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”.**
- 20. **Section 27 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” in the second line and replacing it with “Enactment”.**
- 21. **The text of section 28 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is deleted and replaced with the following:**
 - (1) A registered consolidation of an Enactment shall serve in place of, and shall be as effective as, the original Enactment as amended by all amending Enactments incorporated into the consolidation.
 - (2) A registered consolidation of an enactment shall be copied, certified and distributed in accordance with section 19 of this Act.

22. **Section 30 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” and replacing it with “Enactment”.**
23. **Section 31 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” wherever it appears and replacing it with “Enactment” in each instance.**
24. **The text of section 33 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is deleted and replaced with the following:**
- Electronic versions of Enactments that are made available to the public in portable document format may be relied on by any person as a correct statement of the Enactment as of the date on which it was published but if there is any conflict or inconsistency between the electronic and certified printed versions of the Enactment as at that date the certified printed version shall be taken as definitive for all purposes.
25. **The text of section 34 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is deleted and replaced with the following:**
- Beginning in 2020 and at least every seventh year thereafter the Executive Council shall print and publish the consolidated Acts and the consolidated Subordinate Legislation.
26. **Section 35 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by:**
- (a) **deleting the words “subordinate legislation” and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”; and**
 - (b) **deleting the words “in accordance with regulations enacted by the Executive Council”.**
27. **Section 36 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by:**
- (a) **deleting the words “subordinate legislation” and replacing them with “Subordinate Legislation”; and**
 - (b) **deleting the word “enactment” and replacing it with “Enactment”.**
28. **Section 37 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by:**
- (a) **deleting the words “President-in-Council” and replacing them with “Registrar”; and**
 - (b) **deleting the word “enactments” and replacing it with “Enactments”.**
29. **Section 38 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the comma and the words “followed by” immediately after “enacted” in the second line and replace them with the word “and”.**
30. **Section 39 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the comma and the words “followed by” immediately after “enacted” in the second line and replace them with the word “and”.**
31. **Section 40 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the comma and the words “followed by” immediately after “enacted” in the second line and replace them with the word “and”.**

32. **The text of section 41 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is deleted and replaced with the following:**

A consolidated Act is cited by setting out the short title followed by the designation “Consolidated Inuit Law” or “CIL” followed by the alpha-numeric number assigned to it in the Registry and, in brackets, the day, month and year of the effective date of the most recent amendment incorporated into the Act being consolidated.

33. **The text of section 42 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is deleted and replaced with the following:**

Consolidated Subordinate Legislation is cited by setting out the short title followed by the designation “Consolidated Subordinate Legislation” or “CSL” followed by the alpha-numeric number assigned to it in the Registry and, in brackets, the day, month and year of the effective date of the most recent amendment incorporated into the Subordinate Legislation being consolidated.

34. **The text of section 43 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the comma and all words following “CCBL” and replacing them with “followed by the alpha-numeric number assigned to it in the Registry and, in brackets, the day, month and year of the effective date of most recent amendment incorporated into the Bylaw being consolidated.”**

35. **Section 44 of the *Nunatsiavut Laws Registration Act* is amended by deleting the word “enactment” wherever it appears and replacing it with “Enactment” in each instance.**

36. **Section 15 of the *Nunatsiavut Government Appointments Act* is amended by inserting “and” following the semicolon at the end of subsection (a), replacing the semi-colon at the end of subsection (b) with a period, and deleting subsection (c).**
