# REGULATIONS RESPECTING THE TRANSFER BY INUIT OF A RIGHT TO HARVEST UNDER SECTIONS 12.3.2 AND 12.3.3 OF THE LABRADOR INUIT LAND CLAIMS AGREEMENT

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Schedule A Prescribed Form

The President in Council, acting under the authority of a Declaration of the Executive Council issued under the *Nunatsiavut Government Transitional Powers Act* on the 27th day of February, 2006, is pleased to enact the following regulations:

## **Short Title**

1

These regulations are the Harvest Transfer Regulations.

## Authority

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These regulations are made under subsection 4(2) of the *Nunatsiavut Government Transitional Powers Act* and subsection 12.7.1(e) of the *Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement*.

## Interpretation

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- (1) Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in these regulations have the same meaning as in the *Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement*.
- (2) In these regulations:

"prescribed form" means the form attached as Schedule A which is a part of these regulations.

#### How a Transfer is Made

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- (1) An Inuk who wishes to transfer a right to Harvest must complete the application in section 1 of the prescribed form and submit it to an official in the Department of Natural Resources.
- (2) The Nunatsiavut Government must approve the transfer if the individual to whom the transfer is made is eligible to be a transferee under section 12.3.15 of the Labrador Inuit Land Claims Agreement and signs his or her acceptance of the terms and conditions applicable to the transfer.

## **Conditions Applicable to Transfers**

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- (1) A transfer under this regulation to an individual referred to in subsections 12.3.15 (a), (b), (c), and (d) shall not exceed a term of 5 years.
- (2) A transfer under this regulation to an individual referred to in subsections 12.3.15 (e) or (f) shall not exceed a term of 1 year.
- (3) A transfer referred to in subsection (1) may be revoked by the transferor at any time by written notice to the Nunatsiavut Government and the transferee signed by the transferor or the transferor's guardian.
- (4) A transfer referred to in subsection (2) is not revocable by the transferor during its term.
- (5) All transfers are revoked upon the death of the transferor.
- (6) If a transfer is revoked the transferee must surrender the prescribed form to the Nunatsiavut Government as soon as possible.
- (7) A transferee must carry the prescribed form at all times when Harvesting and must produce it for a law enforcement officer if so requested.
- (8) A transferee Harvesting under a transfer is subject to all terms conditions and restrictions with respect to the Inuit Domestic Harvest.

## Fees

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No fee is payable for a transfer under this regulation.
