REGULATIONS RESPECTING THE REMOVAL FROM OFFICE OF MEMBERS OF THE INUIT MEMBERSHIP APPEAL BOARD

The President in Council is pleased to enact the following regulations:

Short title

1

These regulations may be cited as the *Membership Appeal Board Regulations*.

Authority

2

These regulations are made under subsection 44(g) of the Beneficiaries Enrolment Act, CIL B-1.

Interpretation

3

- (1) Unless the context otherwise requires, terms used in these regulations have the same meaning as in the *Beneficiaries Enrolment Act*, CIL B-1.
- (2) In these regulations:

"Board" means the Inuit Membership Appeal Board;

"Chair" means the chairperson from time to time of the Board and includes the acting chairperson;

"Member" means a member of the Board and includes the Chair;

"Meeting" includes a workshop, course, seminar, conference or other gathering of the Members held for purposes of instructing, training, educating, guiding or directing the Members with respect to their functions or for purposes of improving or developing the capacity of the Board to perform its functions; and

"President" means the President of Nunatsiavut.

Removal of Members from Office

4

- (1) The President will remove from office any Member who does not perform the functions of the office of a Member.
- (2) The President will seek the consent of the Nunatsiavut Executive Council and the recommendation of the Chair before removing a Member from office.

Chair to Recommend Removal from Office

5

- (1) The Chair may recommend that the President remove a Member from office for failure to perform the functions of his or her office as a Member.
- (2) The Chair shall recommend that the President remove from office a Member who does not attend 3 consecutive Meetings of the Board.
