



Need help in getting your Vaccine Passport?

As of Friday, October 22, 2021, individuals 12 years of age and older must be fully vaccinated or have an approved medical exemption to access non-essential activities and places within Newfoundland and Labrador. Proof of vaccination status (**Vaccine Passport**) has to be in the form of a QR Code on a smart phone app called **NLVaxPass**, or an official printed document from the Government of Newfoundland and Labrador.

As of Saturday, October 30, 2021 all air travelers over the age of 12 will need proof of vaccination in order to travel from a Canadian airport on a commercially regular scheduled flight or charter.
