- Reporting to the Director of Tourism the Torngat Mountains Activities Planner will coordinate a variety of files relating to the Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Station;
- Candidate will work year-round and will be required to spend a portion of the summer season at the Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Station;
- Liaise with various stakeholders such as other departments within NG, Parks Canada, Air Borealis and the Nunatsiavut Group of Companies
- Coordinate internal committees and meetings with other departments;
- Develop proposals to secure external funding for youth program, infrastructure needs and other projects relating to the Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Station complete report writing;
- Support budget development ;
- Provide written communications, reports and presentation on Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Station as required;
- Provide support on various aspects of the Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Station file
- Provide coordination and support to the Director of Tourism in identifying linkages between the Torngat Mountains Base Camp and Research Centre and the programming occurring in Hebron;
- Provide logistical support for the Hebron Ambassador Programming
- Other related duties as required

- Understanding of Labrador Inuit culture and of the five Inuit communities;

- Excellent communication and interpersonal skills, including the ability to communicate effectively with persons of a wide variety of backgrounds and skills, including, but not limited to, community members, researchers, government agencies, internal staff, external working groups and others;
