Upon successfully completing the paid Housing Needs Assessment Training in Happy Valley-Goose Bay, Fieldworkers will be ready to take on the following tasks:

- ✓ Make initial contact with survey participants and schedule one-on-one confidential appointments;
- ✓ Use provided tablets to conduct survey questionnaires at personal residences;
- ✓ Ensure information collected is protected;
- ✓ Respond to questions community members may have about the Housing Needs Assessment Survey or about their participation;
- ✓ Other related duties as required.

If you have any of the following, consider applying:

- ✓ A High School Diploma or equivalent
- ✓ Fluency or familiarity with Inuttitut
- ✓ Willingness to work flexible hours
- ✓ Confidence in making cold calls and conducting interviews
- ✓ Ability to travel to other Nunatsiavut communities (not necessarily required)
- ✓ Experience using digital tools such as online or mobile applications for data collection
- ✓ Experience conducting surveys and working with confidential information
